- Attend and support delivery of match day and community-based Villa Vision events and activations
- Assist with ensuring the Villa Vision project complies with critical business functions such as human resources, health and safety, safeguarding, and equality and diversity ensuring compliance with Aston Villa Foundation policies, legislation and best practice
